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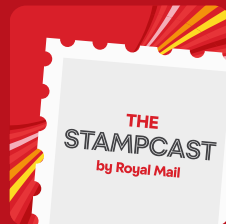

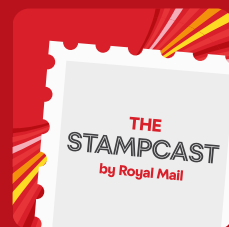

How Queen Victoria made British postal history

Queen Victoria's ascension to the throne in 1837 ushered in an age of remarkable industrial progress. The steam engine transformed transport and trade. The electric lightbulb sparked a new age of productivity. And, perhaps with less fanfare, the Penny Black – the world's first adhesive stamp – revolutionised communication across Britain and beyond, shaping the modern postal system we rely on to keep us connected.

This small square of paper made it secure and affordable for everyone to send letters. Today, it remains a prized collectible, and an enduring symbol of the social transformation that defined the Victorian period.

This commemorative set of stamps and souvenirs celebrates the craft and ingenuity that produced this communication innovation. Eight new stamps reprise the iconic designs featured on the Penny Black and its successive issues, from the striking Twopenny Blue to the rare 4d 'Jubilee'. A beautiful Miniature Sheet exploring Queen Victoria's fascination with early photography features four First Class stamps displaying rare portraits from her reign.

You'll also discover highly collectible keepsakes, including Royal Mint coins and a beautifully illustrated, full-colour publication charting the life and legacy of Queen Victoria and her influence on Britain's postal system.

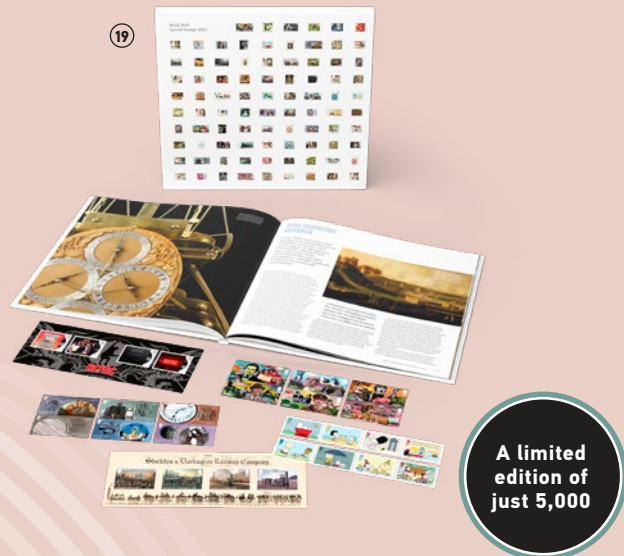

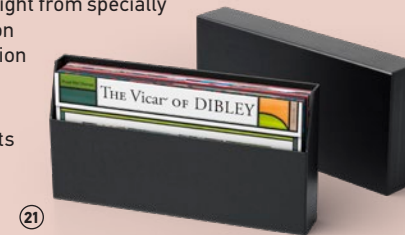

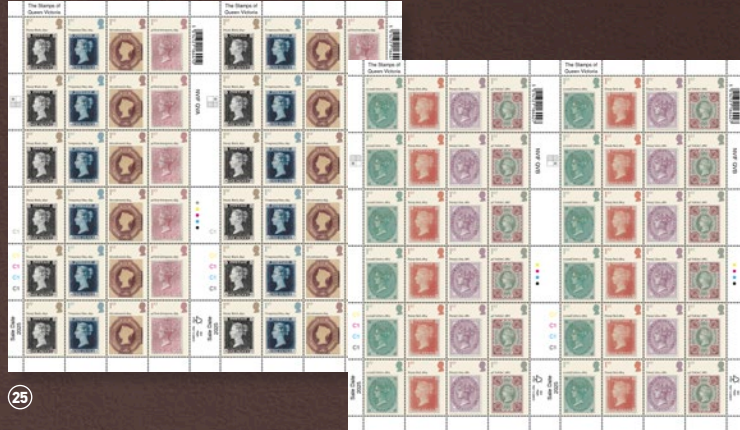
