Our Kings and Queens series began in 2008 and has explored 600 years of the British Monarchy. It now reaches a most fitting conclusion as we come to The House of Windsor in this year of Her Maiesty The Queen's Diamond Jubilee

This great Royal House began with the name Saxe-Coburg-Gotha, which was changed to Windsor by George V's Royal Proclamation in 1917, in order to emphasise the Britishness of the Monarchy at the height of the First World War.

The House of Windsor has now reigned for over a century of great achievements and dramatic events. Despite the turbulence of two world wars and the constitutional crisis of the abdication, it has done so with enormous dianity.




