The five 1st class stamps, printed in horizontal se-tenant strips, feature a humorous representation of an envelope with postman, being kissed, a duck, a baby, and an aeroplane. The Queen's head and service indicator are positioned at top right. The designs are by Satoshi Kambayashi.

The stamps will be issued to Post Office branches in sheets of 25. Sheets of 50, with gutter margin, will be supplied to Royal Mail Tallents House and Post Office philatelic outlets.

FIRST DAY FACILITIES Unstamped Royal Mail FDC envelopes will be available from main Post Office branches and philatelic outlets about a week before 3 February, price 25p. Orders for serviced FDCs must reach Tallents House by the date of issue. Price £2.07 UK or £1.76 overseas. State whether Tallents House Edinburgh or Merry Hill, Wolverhampton postmarks required. Collectors may send stamped covers on the day of issue to: Royal Mail Tallents House, 21 South Gyle Crescent, Edinburgh EH12 9PB, or to Special Handstamp Centre, Royal Mail, St Stephens Street, Birmingham B6 4AA (Merry Hill postmark), marking the outer envelope 'FD0403' or 'FD0404'. Covers can be posted or handed in at main Post Office branches for the Merry Hill postmark. Details of sponsored handstamps will be announced in the *British Postmark Bulletin* — available on subscription from Tallents House. 
