
Cathedrals Six new stamps and a miniature

PHILATELIC PRODUCTS The presentation pack, which includes both the six stamps and the miniature sheet, was designed by Russell Warren-Fisher. Maev Kennedy writes about cathedrals in general, and the Dean and Chapter of St Paul's have provided text about their Cathedral. The illustrations include the famous Whispering Gallery of St Paul's. There will be a set of 11 stamp cards, featuring the six stamps, the four miniature sheet stamps, and the sheet itself. A St Paul's medal cover will be available, as will number one in a new Cathedrals ingot series. Details will be given nearer the time.

The stamps are designed by Howard Brown and printed in litho by Joh Enschedé Stamps of the Netherlands.
